## Responsibilities:

- 1. Select and plan music for Sunday and agreed midweek services.
- Participate in the creative planning of the Sunday and special services with the Senior Pastor
- 3. Recruit, equip, motivate and supervise music team leaders and musicians.
- 4. Develop musical teams and ensembles for services.
- 5. Maintain a strong prayer base for the music ministry.
- 6. Communicate regularly with the Senior Pastor and staff.
- 7. Participate in the life and ministry of the church.

### **Qualifications:**

- 1. Authentic relationship with Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord.
- 2. Ability to shepherd volunteer musicians in the Christian life.
- 3. Love and respect for people.
- 4. Attested musical skills and competence.
- 5. Ability to organise, coordinate, and motivate musicians and technical team members.
- 6. A positive attitude.
- 7. Strong team player with the rest of the staff and congregation.
- 8. Committed to the church's vision, leadership, and people.
- 9. Dependable, responsible, self-motivated and creative.

#### **Musical Competencies:**

- 1. Ability in wide range of styles including Christian classics (hymns) but with a focus on contemporary music.
- 2. Ability to lead worship and to train others as individual and team worship leaders.
- 3. Producing and directing special events, musicals and programs.
- 4. Experience with technical aspects of contemporary services: for example, sound boards, theatre lights, video editing, etc.—a plus.
